

**Attire Requirements for Showing at Fair**  
**(Approved helmet required for all riding classes)**

**English Hunter Type:**

- Knee-high hunt boots or jodhpur boots (short boots)
- Solid-color (not white) breeches or jodhpurs
- Long-sleeved shirt or blouse required if coat is not worn; short-sleeved may be worn under a hunt coat
- Hunt coat (recommended, but not required) should be conservative color, never red
- Tie, stock, or choker is required
- Hair must be neat and contained – as in a braid or hairnet, but must not obscure the exhibitor's number
- Traditional attire is preferred
- Optional: gloves, paddock boots and boot-like half-chaps instead of hunt boots
- Prohibited: white breeches, spurs in halter and showmanship classes

**English Saddle Type:**

- Minimum requirements: tailored long pants, long-sleeved shirt or blouse with a tie, jodhpur boots
- Suitable coat is recommended; a traditional saddle suit with matching jacket and pants is preferred, especially in equitation and showmanship
- Hair must be restrained
- Optional: gloves, derby hat in halter classes
- Prohibited: spurs in halter and showmanship classes

**Western:**

- Minimum requirements: western-style long pants or jeans, long-sleeved shirt with collar (band, standup, tuxedo, etc.), western boots with a heel, western hat or helmet in halter and showmanship classes
- Optional: coats, vests, jackets, gloves
- Optional: chaps or spurs can be used only in performance (riding) classes
